

### Fields of Uxbridge NEW Outdoor Courts Opening Soon

UPC (Uxbridge Pickleball Club) is excited to start a new spring/summer/fall pickleball program at Fields of Uxbridge Park.

To join you simply have to be a UPC member by joining Pickleball Canada and Pickleball Ontario, annual fee of \$20. See the link <u>pickleballontario.org</u>. Then register with UPC through the same website for outdoor session #3.

#### Fees

- The fees include 6 month use of pickleball courts during UPC specified times. Access to clinics and skill days for all ages, along with member tournaments.
- The fees also include parking.
- Adults \$85 and children 17 and under \$40 for the entire season with no court fees.

UPC Member Registration - the "how to" for summer pickleball in Uxbridge (1 of 2 slides)

- 1. Go to pickleballcanada.org and login.
- 2. Go to MY ACCOUNT (top left tab) and choose UXBRIDGE PICKLEBALL CLUB.
- 3. Tap onto REGISTRATION OPENED (green tab).
- 4. Scroll down to demographic and touch blue "lookup".
- 5. Fill out demographic information on pop up.
- 6. Reminder check off whether you have a disability, located under last name.
- 7. Check your email and phone number are correct.


# UPC Member Registration - the "how to" for summer pickleball in Uxbridge (2 of 2 slides)

- 8. Make sure you haven't opted out of UPC emails.
- 9. Waivers after you have read them all, check them off, 7 in all.
- 10. Follow the prompts, choose 2025 May-Oct Uxbridge Outdoors (Adults). It will take you back to check off some NEW QUESTIONS.
  - Can choose to join UPC What's App to communicate with the members
  - License plate#'s (leave one space between 2 plate numbers).
  - Be part of a ladder? Show interest in clinics, skills/drills
- 11. Proceed to payment. Digital signature required.

12. Congrats you are registered! You will get a confirmation of payment by email. (no second step!)

## Things you need to know ...

- To differentiate between UPC members who have purchased the summer outdoor session vs those who have not, we ask that every summer member print off an ID card and have it stamped by the one of the board members. Then you can laminate it and have it handy in your pickleball bag to show if questioned by the public or township.
- 2. Bring your own paddle and outdoor pickleballs. The Franklin X40 is recommended.
- 3. Also good to have a first aid kit in your car as UPC is not able to provide one for the outdoor courts.

4. Print off your <u>Personal Pickleball Canada ID Card</u> from Pickleball website.

See instructions below to obtain your personal ID card.

- i) Access website pickleballcanada.org
- ii) Select "My Registrations" from LEFT grey column.
- iii) Select green tab "Membership Card"
- iv) Select blue "Membership Card"
- v) Print off your Pickleball Canada ID Card.

Your personal ID card will <u>need to be stamped with UPC Logo</u> for proof you are a member of UPC Outdoor Courts.
